

SMOKING POLICY (July 2014)

(a) General. Y-12 Consolidated Nuclear Security, LLC (CNS) is committed to ensuring the health and safety of its employees and to providing a comfortable and productive work environment. It is the policy of Y-12 CNS to prohibit smoking in all Y-12 CNS buildings, enclosed areas, on rooftops, and in government vehicles, and equipment. Smoking is prohibited when walking between buildings and across the site, at portal and post entrances, near entry and exit lines, and near shuttle/taxi pickup areas.

(b) Designated Smoking Areas. Smoking is allowed only in Designated Smoking Areas and in remote areas. Designated Smoking Areas are located near most large buildings.

(c) Remote Areas. Personnel working (e.g., while mowing or sampling) in remote areas (i.e., areas that are away from personnel and buildings) should not smoke within 25 feet of non-smoking co-workers.

(d) Butts and Ashes. All butts and ashes must be placed in proper receptacles. This applies when working in remote areas or traveling in a personal vehicle.

(e) Electronic Cigarettes. Although electronic cigarettes are not tobacco products, their use is also limited to designated areas to avoid confusion with the implementation of this policy.

(f) Subcontracts. The Seller shall include this clause in subcontracts involving work done on site at the Y-12 National Security Complex.
